Safety has always been our top priority for passengers and crews, and because of that, the social distancing and cleaning procedures that have become a new way of life for all of us across the world. Rest assured that we are constantly monitoring the situation in order to resume flight operations in the future, and while we wait to welcome you back, we've been using our internal resources to do our part to get ready including recent feedback obtained from #LOTdoDomu repatriation missions.
