

Dear Agent,

Kindly note below as per Pakistan Civil Aviation Authority Implementation of Standard Operating Procedures for International Passenger /Chartered/Private Aircraft Flights.

The SOP for international passengers requires negative RT-PCR test conducted not more than 96 Hours for passengers travelling to Pakistan will come into effect from October 05,2020 and shall remain effective till December 31, 2020.

Requirement of COVID-19 RT-PCR test from passengers traveling to Pakistan is subject to the country of original embarkation effective from October 05,2020. (M/O NHR&C) has categorized countries into two categories A and B. Asymptomatic Travellers from Category A countries do not require RT PCR test before commencement of Travel, Whereas, Travellers from Category B require to provide proof of negative RT PCR test conducted not more than 96 hours from the commencement of original travel, failing which the operator/Airlines shall not issue the boarding pass.

All agents are to ensure full compliance with the instructions contained in the (SOP) Standard Operating Procedures. This SOP supersedes all previous subject SOPs.
