

Dear Travel Partner,

Over the last few weeks the Trade has kindly showed interest regarding Uzbekistan Airway's 2020 Winter & 2021 Summer schedules.

To clarify, the airline is working hard to restart its LHR operations for the remainder of the year. It is unlikely a service will operate in October and we are awaiting further direction on services for November onwards. APG will advise the trade as soon as we have notification. I can confirm however, that the airline is operating other routes on its network all bookable through the normal means.

As for Summer 2021, we are expecting late November / early December loadings. If not submitted already, please forward 2020 group allocations for my attention.

Conditions of travel on Uzbekistan Airways regardless of origin / destination:

Passengers are required to have a PCR certificate with the following conditions below.

- Passengers at place of origin must provide a certificate confirming a negative test result for COVID-19 by PCR in English or Russian. The test must be valid no more than 72 hours before the flight. (In the absence of a negative test result, passengers will be denied check-in for their flight).
 - When arriving in Uzbekistan - passengers again need to present the certificate as mentioned above. Passengers will have their temperature taken and will be required to complete a health questionnaire - thereby committing to a 14-day self-isolation period if needed to do so.
 - Passengers with fever or other cold / flu symptoms will be examined at Tashkent airport
 - Passengers who have tested positive following a PCR test in TAS will be hospitalized for treatment.
