

Dear Travel Trade Partner,

Effective today, the National Medical Taskforce for combating the Coronavirus announced a reduction in the cost of PCR laboratory tests for all arrivals into the Kingdom of Bahrain, including citizens, residents, and visitors from BHD 60 to BHD 40.

The BHD 40 fee will cover the PCR arrival test, as well as the test to be conducted on the 10th day of arrival into Bahrain.

Bahrain Entry Requirements:

1) PCR Test: All arriving passengers must undergo a PCR test (at their own expense) upon arrival at a cost of BHD 40.00 (USD 107.00), Payments can be made on arrival in cash and electronically, or in advance via the 'BeAware Bahrain' mobile application. All Arrivals must remain in self-isolation until the result of the PCR test has been determined. Transit passengers and children below the age of 6 are not required to undergo testing.

Note: you can use the same PCR Certificate for your next destination at no extra charge (so you don't have to pay multi PCR).

2) Quarantine: There's no quarantine towards all passengers entering the Kingdom of Bahrain with negative COVID19 test result which should be taken on arrival at Bahrain Airport.

3) Face Mask: Wearing masks in public in Bahrain has been compulsory since the start of April, Mask regime is applied everywhere indoors or outdoors unless seated for meals in the restaurants or coffee shops.. etc
