

PUBLIC ADVISORY ON ENTRY RESTRICTIONS INTO THE PHILIPPINES

27 NOVEMBER 2020

Pursuant to Inter Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) Resolution No. 85 dated 26 November 2020, and with reference to Republic Act No. 6768, as amended, the following shall be exempted from the temporary suspension of visa-free privileges <u>starting 07</u> December 2020:

- Filipino citizens' foreign spouses and children, regardless of age, who are travelling with them; and
- 2. Former Filipino citizens, together with their foreign spouses and children, regardless of age, who are travelling with them;

Please note that the entry of above mentioned foreign nationals shall be subject to the following conditions:

- 1. They must be nationals permitted/allowed to enter the country visa-free under Executive Order No. 408, s. 1960;
- 2. They must have a pre-booked quarantine facility;
- 3. They must have a pre-booked COVID-19 testing at a laboratory operating at the airport; and
- 4. They are subject to the maximum capacity of inbound passengers at the port of entry and during the date of entry.

Further, the entry of the above mentioned foreign nationals shall be subject to the implementing guidelines to be issued by the Bureau of Immigration.

Other foreign spouses and children of Filipino nationals who do not belong to the above categories, are still subject to existing travel restrictions. They should email <u>visa@phembassy·us.org</u> to inquire if they are qualified for a visa.
