Emirates flexible re-booking policy provides customers more opportunities to use their unused tickets or to book tickets for future plans. In addition Emirates continues to offer the **multi-risk travel insurance** to keep all our customers safe on their journeys and giving them extra security wherever they are in the world.

We have recently revised our waiver policy to offer even more flexibility. Kindly refer to the below important changes made to our Covid-19 travel waiver policy.

- The Covid waiver policy has been extended for tickets with scheduled Emirates departure on/before 31 December 2021.
- Validity of the tickets are further extended from 760 days to an additional 365 days on all the tickets issued on/before 31 March 2021 with schedule Emirates departure on/before 31 December 2021. The total ticket validity for such tickets will be 1125 days from original ticket issue date.
- Tickets issued on/after 01 April 2021 with the travel date on/before 31 December 2021 will continue to have a 760 days validity from the original ticket issue date.
