## SUBJECT: Waiver 17/SIN/2021-SINGAPORE

Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore vide their CAAS Circular 2021/22 dated 22 April 2021, stating that with effect from 23 April 2021, Singapore will ban entry for all passengers from India except Singapore Citizens (SCs) and Singapore Permanent Residents (SPRs).

In view of the same, it has been decided to allow one free date change to passengers holding confirmed 098 documents for sector India-Singapore-India, during the period of ban. In case of same RBD not available, passengers may be booked in available RBD maintaining the same cabin, although efforts must be made to book in the next higher RBD. Date may be changed to any future date as per validity of the ticket.

In case passenger wants to cancel, NIL charges will apply.

Free change can be availed only once, in case of subsequent changes, rules as per the original booking RBD will apply.
