

# Show the **"Quarantine"** screen of **OCHA** at check-in and to quarantine authorities on arrival

Holders of the Olympic/Paralympic Identity and Accreditation Card (OIAC / PIAC) or a Pre-Valid Card (PVC) (which will be validated into their OIAC/ PIAC) <u>must show</u> <u>the "Quarantine"</u> screen with the required information entered of <u>OCHA</u> installed in their mobile phones both <u>to airline staff at check-in</u> and <u>at Japanese</u> <u>quarantine authorities on arrival</u>.

#### Please input all necessary information onto OCHA before departure.




- ※ If you hold OIAC/PIAC/PVC but your mobile phone is not compatible to OCHA, please show the "Written Pledge" delivered by Tokyo Organising Committee of Olympic and Paralympic (Tokyo 2020) instead. You can rent a mobile phone at the arrival airport from Tokyo 2020.
- X In the case you enter Japan with "Written Pledge" / "Prior Consent Form", please show it at check-in and at. Japanese quarantine authorities on arrival.
