



UK eases travel restrictions for travellers from Qatar

Dear Valued Partner,

In line with the latest UK governmental guidelines effective **8 August 2021**, Bahrain, India, Qatar and UAE will be moved to the United Kingdom's Amber list, leading to an ease of travel restrictions into England.

Before travelling to the UK:



- Clients must take a COVID-19 test at least three days prior to travel to the UK.
- Book and pay in advance for COVID-19 tests to be taken in the UK.

Arrival into the UK:



- Clients must self-quarantine at a private address for 10 days and undergo two COVID-19 tests, one on or before Day 2 and the second on or after Day 8.
- If your clients have been fully vaccinated in the USA, the UK or Europe, they will not be required to self-quarantine and will only be required to take one COVID-19 test on Day 2.
- If they have been in a country from the UK's Red List within the 10 days prior to their travel to the UK, they will only be allowed to enter the UK if they are a British or Irish National, or if they have residence rights in the UK. Such clients will be required to undergo mandatory hotel quarantine for 10 days.
