Dear Travel Trade Partners,

In accordance with the decisions taken by UK authorities, **Nigeria** will be added to the UK <u>red list</u> at **4am on Monday 6 December 2021.** 

Angola, Botswana, Eswatini, Lesotho, Malawi, Mozambique, Namibia, Zambia and Zimbabwe were added to the UK red list previously.

If passengers have been in any of the red list countries in the 10 days before they arrive in England, they must quarantine in a managed hotel. They must **book a quarantine hotel package, including 2 COVID-19 tests**, before they arrive in England.

If passengers have been in a country or territory on the red list in the 10 days before they arrive in England, they will only be allowed to enter the UK if they either:

- are a British or Irish National
- have residence rights in the UK

If passengers live in England, they should not travel to countries or territories on the red list.

## Before passengers travel to England - red list rules

Before passengers travel to England they must:

- take a COVID-19 test they must take the test in the 3 days before they travel to England
- book a quarantine hotel package, including 2 COVID-19 tests
- complete a passenger locator form

They must do this even if they are fully vaccinated.

Please refer to the complete Government guidance on red list rules for further details on what passengers must do before travelling to and after arriving in England.

Please be reminded that all passengers arriving into a UK airport must be informed and advised verbally and/or in writing by the agency regarding the UK Government's "Entering the UK" procedures detailed on <a href="https://www.gov.uk/uk-border-control">www.gov.uk/uk-border-control</a>.

It is currently a legal requirement for agents to ensure that all passengers arriving to the UK are provided with the latest public health and related duties information on <a href="https://www.gov.uk/uk-border-control">www.gov.uk/uk-border-control</a>.

Please apply our current COVID-19 related procedures and passengers rights policy for passengers who are not permitted to travel by the country of departure/arrival due to COVID-19 restrictions.
