Subject – Bahrain Entry Rules

Dear Travel Trade Partner,

Passengers arriving at the Kingdom of Bahrain as their final destination:

- 1.** GCC citizens shall use their passport to enter Bahrain; national ID card is not accepted

- 2.** VOA is available to eligible passengers disembarking in Bahrain. GCC residents can get Visa on Arrival to enter Bahrain if they are arriving from UAE, Oman, Kuwait & KSA only.

- 3.** Pax are not allowed to enter Bahrain unless they are:
 - a. Bahraini citizens
 - b. GCC citizens who do not require visas
 - c. Passengers who reside in Bahrain
 - d. Passengers with a valid e-visa granted prior to boarding
 - e. Passengers who are eligible for visa on arrival
 - f. This does not apply to airline crew
 - g. Diplomats, Military personnel and their dependents, and those travelling on official government business, are exempt from all covid-19-related entry protocols, including but not limited to, pre-departure testing, arrival testing, and quarantine.

- 4.** All other passengers are permitted to transit through BIA; maximum allowable transit time in BAH is 12 hrs.

Non-vaccinated or passengers without a vaccination certificate approved by Govt. of Bahrain	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> PCR test with QR Code - 48hrs before departure Upon arrival, 5th & 10th day 	10 days Precautionary quarantine at place of residence	Passengers must provide proof of a residence either owned or leased by PAX or an immediate family member before boarding
Transit Passengers through Kingdom of Bahrain from Non-Red list countries	N/A	N/A	Must meet all requirements of final destination

Note:

- i. Fully vaccinated passengers means those who have completed 2 weeks after the last dose of vaccines.
 - ii. **Vaccines approved by WHO are Moderna, Pfizer-BioNtech, Janssen (Johnson & Johnson), Oxford – AstraZeneca, Covishield – AstraZeneca, Sinopharm , Sinovac & Covaxin**
 - iii. Passengers (below 6years of age): exempted from testing & quarantine requirements
 - iv. Passengers (6 to 12 years): testing requirements are applicable. Quarantine is exempted.
 - v. Passengers above 12 years & fully vaccinated with approved vaccines): testing requirements are applicable. Quarantine is exempted.
 - vi. All cost associated with testing must be borne by passengers.
6. Passengers above 06 years are required to download BeAware app
