

## **Notice To Agents: 28a 24th December 2021 PASSENGERS TRAVELLING TO KENYA - update**

Dear Travel Partner,

This Agents Notice replaces Agents Notice 0028 dated 22nd December 2021.

Effective from 21<sup>st</sup> December 2021, the following is the general travel requirement for all passengers entering/transiting to Kenya:

### **Passengers travelling to Kenya:**

- 1. Guests whose final destination is Kenya must have a certificate of COVID-19 vaccination. Travellers below the age of eighteen (18) years are exempt from this requirement.**
- 2. Guests who are in transit in Nairobi are not required to show certificate of COVID-19 vaccination however, must ensure the requirements of the destination station has been met.**
3. All passengers coming to Kenya must be in possession of a valid COVID-19 negative PCR test certificate conducted within **72 hours** before departure regardless of the route of entry.
4. Children below the age of five (5) years are exempt from this requirement.
5. All travellers will be expected to fill the travellers' locator form and submit before travel to

<http://bit.ly/covid19moh> and thereafter submit daily health information to "jitenge" platform for 14 consecutive days.

6. All passengers with flu-like symptoms at the point of entry, or those who develop clinical symptoms within 14 days of arrival shall be placed into quarantine and be tested for COVID19 at a government testing facility.
7. Any person who tests positive on antigen RDT at any point of entry will be isolated at a Ministry of Health designated facility or at home for returning Kenyans and residents for ten (10) days at the travellers own cost. Further they shall be subjected to a COVID-19 PCR test before discharge.

Passengers travelling out of Kenya will require a COVID 19 vaccination certificate. In addition, they will be required to abide by the particular travel, health and COVID-19 related requirements of the destination country.
