**Dear travel partner,**

We inform with immediate effect that all passengers arriving in Brazil must present cumulatively:

- **Vaccination Certificate**
- **Negative RT-PCR test performed within 72 hours, or Antigen test performed within 24 hours before boarding**
- Printed or electronic proof of completion of the [Traveler's Health Declaration - DSV](#), up to 24 hours before boarding.

Passengers traveling without a vaccination certificate are prohibited from entering Brazil. Boarding will be denied to unvaccinated passengers, except:

- Nationals and residents in Brazil;
- Children under 12 years old;
- Passengers considered not eligible for vaccination due to clinical contraindication, provided it is attested by a medical report;
- Passengers not eligible for vaccination due to age, according to the criteria defined by the Ministry of Health in the National Operationalization Plan for Vaccination against COVID-19 and published on the Ministry of Health website;
- Due to humanitarian issues, according to article 18 of [Ordinance No. 663, December 20, 2021](#)
- Passengers from countries with low vaccination coverage disclosed by the Ministry of Health and published on the Ministry of Health website;

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** Passengers exempt from presenting a vaccination certificate because they are ineligible to receive the vaccine against COVID 19, may only be accepted after medical evaluation by TAP, following the **MEDIF** process. For this purpose, the appropriate authorization must be included in the reservation.

Passengers should be informed that the rules may change again at any time.
