Dear travel partner,

We inform with immediate effect that all passengers arriving in Brazil must present cumulatively:

- Vaccination Certificate
- Negative RT-PCR test performed within 72 hours, or Antigen test performed within 24 hours before boarding
- Printed or electronic proof of completion of the <u>Traveler's Health Declaration</u> <u>DSV</u>, up to 24 hours before boarding.

Passengers traveling without a vaccination certificate are prohibited from entering Brazil. Boarding will be denied to unvaccinated passengers, except:

- Nationals and residents in Brazil;
- Children under 12 years old;
- Passengers considered not eligible for vaccination due to clinical contraindication, provided it is attested by a medical report;
- Passengers not eligible for vaccination due to age, according to the criteria defined by the Ministry of Health in the National Operationalization Plan for Vaccination against COVID-19 and published on the Ministry of Health website;
- Due to humanitarian issues, according to article 18 of <u>Ordinance No. 663</u>, <u>December 20</u>, 2021
- Passengers from countries with low vaccination coverage disclosed by the Ministry of Health and published on the Ministry of Health website;

IMPORTANT NOTE: Passengers exempt from presenting a vaccination certificate because they are ineligible to receive the vaccine against COVID 19, may only be accepted after medical evaluation by TAP, following the **MEDIF** process. For this purpose, the appropriate authorization must be included in the reservation.

Passengers should be informed that the rules may change again at any time.

We count on you for the communication of this very important information to the passengers.
