Subject :- Singapore Transit Requirements

Dear Travel Trade Partner,

Please be advised, passengers intending to enter or transit through Singapore are required to take a COVID-19 test within 2 days before departure for Singapore and present a valid negative COVID-19 test for entry to Singapore.

Please see below Singapore transit requirements

- Do not accept passenger transiting in SIN to other airlines
- Passengers transiting in SIN on Gulf Air (GF165 & GF166 only) are required to present PDT (Pre departure test) taken within 48hrs of departure regardless of their vaccination status.
- All passengers must submit the electronic Health Declaration before they enter Singapore using SG Arrival Card e-services. This can be done within 3 days of arrival.

This applies to:

o Singapore Citizens, Permanent Residents, Long-Term Pass Holders (Students Pass, Dependant Pass, Long Term Visit Pass & Work Pass), Foreign visitors, travellers enrolled in the frequent traveller program.

All passengers entering Singapore are required to undergo arrival PCR at Changi Airport. Following groups are exempted.

- Passengers aged 2years old and below in the calendar year
- Crew of a merchant ocean-going vessel who arrive as a transit passenger for the purpose of embarking on the vessel in Singapore
