Dear Travel Partner,

Please kindly be informed of the new rules entering Bangkok, Thailand.

From 1 February, 2022, fully vaccinated travelers from any country around the world can apply for a TEST & GO Thailand Pass up to 60 days in advance. All new TEST & GO Thailand Pass applications must submit proof of prepayment for 2 RT-PCR tests and accommodation (SHA Extra Plus (SHA++), AQ, OQ, or AHQ) on Day 1 and Day 5, as well as a prearranged transfer on Day 1 Eligible travelers:

- Thai citizens.
- Foreign travelers, including but not limited to diplomats, guests of the government, Thai work permit holders, students and their family, and patients seeking medical treatment.

Eligible countries

- All countries/territories. Pre-Arrival Requirements All travelers must have the following documents for entering Thailand:
 1. A Thailand Pass, which can be applied via <https://tp.consular.go.th/>. *The system will reopen for new TEST & GO applications from 1 February, 2022 (09.00 Hrs. Thailand Time) (QR Code for Thailand Pass is valid for 72 hours from the date as stipulated on the QR Code)
 2. A Medical Certificate with an RT-PCR lab result indicating that COVID-19 is not detected issued no more than 72 hours before travelling.

Travelers under 6 years of age, travelling with parents with a negative RT-PCR test result within 72 hours before travelling, are not required to have a pre-arrival negative RT-PCR test result and can have a saliva test when entering the Kingdom.

For arrivals by water, everyone on board the vessels must have a medical certificate with an RT-PCR lab result indicating that COVID-19 is not detected within the officially specified time frame. Anyone on board with a history of COVID-19 infection within a period between 14-90 days must have a medical certificate of recovery.

- 3. An insurance policy with coverage no less than US\$50,000. TAT recommends that travelers make sure to check the small print of any COVID-19 insurance policy before purchasing. Ultimately, the policy should cover the cost of treatment and other medical expenses associated with being infected with COVID-19, including in-patient hospitalisation, hospital isolation, hotel isolation, or related quarantine. The insurance policy should also cover the whole duration that travelers are planning to stay in Thailand, plus at least 10 extra days as a precautionary measure in the event that the traveler's second swab test result returns as positive.
- Thais and foreign expatriates under Thailand's national healthcare coverage are exempt from this requirement.

Hotel package must include transport pick up from Airport to hotel and RT-PCR test on arrival at hotel. If passenger present THAILAND PASS QR code without pick-up and RT-PCR test facility, do not accept the passenger to board the aircraft and instruct the passenger to make new hotel reservation
Transit Requirements: all passengers transiting through Singapore are required to present PDT taken within 48hrs of departure regardless of their vaccination status/destination requirements Approved vaccines are Sinovac, AstraZeneca or Covishield, Pfizer, Janssen, Moderna, Sinopharm and Sputnik V.

Passengers transit/transfer to international flights: a. Passenger must hold a. Medical certificate with the laboratory result indicating that COVID-19 is not detected by RT-PCR not more than 72 Hrs before departure. b. Health insurance cover COVID-19 medical expense and treatment during in Thailand not less than USD50,000
b. Passengers transfer to other airline must hold Single PNR/ Same booking or conjunction ticket must show in passenger PNR. c. (This is very importance GF BKK has to submit information regarding passenger with connecting flight to CAAT 24 hrs before our flight arrive BKK.) d. Baggage must be checked through. e. Maximum transit time is 24 Hrs. f. There will be no Lab test service for COVID-19 at transit/transfer point. Note: Please do not accept passenger connecting to low cost airline or airline which not have agreement with Gulf Air, passenger will be rejected
Transfer from international flight to domestic flight in Thailand is allowed on PG restricted 4 digit flight PG52xx to Phuket Sandbox Model, effective 01 Feb 2022
Transfer from international flight to domestic flight in Thailand is still not allowed, except only to USM and HKT Phuket Sandbox which effective 01 Feb 2022 with PG restricted 4 digits flight number as below ; BKK-USM PG5125 STD 1200LT BKK-HKT PG5275 STD 1200LT PG5171 STD 1710LT PG5279 STD 1710LT

Note 3: Required for any person who registers for 7-day quarantine

Note 4: Travel insurance must cover the period of stay in Thailand and must cover at least USD 50 000

Remarks

- * Passport holders of Brazil and Peru are entitled for tourist visa exemption scheme. Meanwhile, Thailand also holds bilateral agreements on visa exemption for holders of diplomatic, official and ordinary passports for a visit of not exceeding 90 days with Brazil and Peru.
- ** Passport holders of Vietnam and Hong Kong are entitled for tourist visa exemption scheme. Meanwhile, Thailand also holds bilateral agreements on visa exemption for holders of diplomatic, official and ordinary passports for a visit of not exceeding 30 days with Vietnam and Hong Kong.
- ** Passport holders of countries/territories entitled for visa exemption scheme are required to obtain the Certificate of Entry (COE) issued by the Royal Thai Embassy/Consulate-General before entering Thailand. (Applicants can apply COE at www.coethailand.mfa.go.th)
