The below email and attached GACA circular regarding updated Procedures for Travel to/from the Kingdom.

The same is for your kind information and disseminate to all concern staff.

Top Urgent

Reference is made to our Circulars on 27 July, 3 November, 16 & 21 December 2021 and on 24 January 2022, please find attached above GACA Circular advising the updated procedures for travel to/from the Kingdom according to the following:

- 1- Airlines must ensure that Saudi Citizens departing from the Kingdom have received the booster dose of the COVID-19 Vaccine for those who had spent three month after receiving the second dose. This condition does not apply to people under the age of (16) sixteen years and exempted people from the vaccine according to Tawakkalna Application.
- 2- Airlines must ensure that ALL passengers including Saudi Citizens travelling to the Kingdom regardless of their immunization status hold a **valid negative COVID-19 Certificates (PCR) OR COVID-19 Antigen Test carried out within (48) hours before their departure to the Kingdom.** Children below the age of (8) eight years are exempted from this requirement, with consideration to the Regulations related to the test procedures of virus infection in the Country of departure.
- 3- Saudi Citizens who had tested positive for COVID-19 shall be allowed to enter the Kingdom without the need for re-test after the below period had elapsed:
 - After (7) seven days from the date on which they have been tested positive for those who had received full doses of the vaccines approved in the Kingdom.

- After (10) ten days from the date on which they have been tested positive for those who have not received full doses of the vaccines approved in the Kingdom.

4- The above procedures will come into effect at 01:00 AM on Wednesday 09/02/2022 G corresponding to 08/07/1443H.
