



QUICK GUIDES

INBOUND AIR TRAVEL TO BRUNEI DARUSSALAM FOR GREEN LIST COUNTRY/REGION (EFFECTIVE 1 APRIL 2022)

> This guide applies to air travel only. Updated: 30 March 2022

Entry Travel Pass (ETP) Approval:

Not Required.

Travel Purpose:

Non-Essential travel is permitted.

Travel History:

Remain in Green List country/region in the last 7 consecutive days before departure.

Pre-Departure Requirements

- Must be fully vaccinated.
- Install BruHealth App.
- Complete Arrival Declaration Form on PMO Travel Portal.
- Foreign nationals entering Brunei for short visit purpose are required to obtain a Travel Medical Insurance with COVID-19 coverage (minimum coverage of BND\$50,000).

Swab Test Requirements

- Pre-departure RT-PCR test (2 days prior) or ART (1 day prior).
- Make online payment for the post-arrival RT-PCR test and ART (BND\$100) via the Arrival Declaration Form.
- COVID-19 Recovered Travellers can show their Recovery Certificate (Validity period not more than 90 days) to be exempted from pre-departure RT-PCR test.

3 Airport Check-in Document Requirements

- > Vaccination Record.
- Arrival Declaration Form.
- Certificate of negative result for RT-PCR test or ART.
- Payment receipt for post-arrival RT-PCR test and ART.
- Certificate of Travel Medical Insurance with COVID-19 coverage (for foreign nationals).
- Valid visa / immigration pass (for nationalities that require it).

Post-Arrival Requirements

- Required to undergo both RT-PCR and ART upon arrival.
- Required to undergo additional ART on Day 2 and Day 3. Upload ART results onto ART Report Feature on BruHealth App
- Self-Isolation at hotel accommodation or home residence until receipt of negative result for post-arrival RT-PCR test.
- COVID-19 Recovered Travellers are only required to undergo ART upon arrival (Fee of BND\$20.00) and exempted from mandatory self-isolation.

*Day of arrival is Day 1

Individuals below 18 years travelling with a group of all vaccinated adults will follow Vaccinated Traveller protocols.

QUICK GUIDES

INBOUND AIR TRAVEL FOR NON-GREEN LIST COUNTRY/ REGION & UNVACCINATED TRAVELLERS (EFFECTIVE 1 APRIL 2022)

This guide applies to air travel only. Updated:30 March 2022

Entry Travel Pass (ETP) Approval:

Only required for Foreign Nationals.

Travel Purpose:

Essential travel only.

Pre-Departure Requirements

- Must be fully vaccinated.
- Unvaccinated individuals must show proof of medical exemption for COVID-19 vaccination.
- Foreign nationals must apply for Entry Travel Pass (ETP) from Prime Minister's Office on Travel Portal (www.pmo.gov.bn/travelportal)
- p Install BruHealth App.
- Complete Arrival Declaration Form on PMO Travel Portal.
- Foreign nationals entering Brunei for short visit purpose are required to obtain a Travel Medical Insurance with COVID-19 coverage (minimum coverage of BND\$50,000).

Swab Test Requirements

- Pre-departure RT-PCR test (2 days prior) or ART (1 day prior).
- Make online payment for the post-arrival RT-PCR test and ART (BND\$100) via the Arrival Declaration Form.
- COVID-19 Recovered Travellers can show their Recovery Certificate (Validity period not more than 90 days) to be exempted from pre-departure RT-PCR test.

Airport Check-in Document Requirements

- Vaccination Record or Certificate of Medical Exemption for COVID-19 vaccination (for unvaccinated individuals).
- Entry Travel Pass (for foreign nationals only).
- Arrival Declaration Form.
- Certificate of negative result for RT-PCR test or ART.
- Receipt for post-arrival RT-PCR test and ART.
- Certificate of Travel Medical Insurance with COVID-19 coverage (for foreign nationals).
- Valid visa / immigration pass (for nationalities that require it).

Post-Arrival Requirements

- Required to undergo ART upon arrival.
- Required to undergo RT-PCR test on Day 5 at a designated swab centre (Day of arrival is Day 1).
- Self-isolate at a hotel accommodation or home residence until receipt of negative result for post-arrival RT-PCR test on Day 5.
- COVID-19 Recovered Travellers are only required to undergo ART upon arrival (Fee of BND\$20.00) and exempted from mandatory self-isolation.

*Day of arrival is Day 1

Individuals below 18 years travelling with a group of all vaccinated adults will follow Vaccinated Traveller protocols.

5 QUICK GUIDES

OUTBOUND AIR TRAVEL TO ANY COUNTRY OF DESTINATION (EFFECTIVE 1 APRIL 2022)

This guide applies to air travel only. Updated: 30 March 2022

Prime Minister's Office (PMO) Exit Approval:

Travellers exiting Brunei Darussalam to any destination do not require PMO Exit Approval.

Health and Vaccination Requirements:

Fully vaccinated with the second dose not more than 3 months prior to departure or have received a booster dose. Comply with all relevant testing and quarantine requirements on return to Brunei.

e-Registration:

Brunei Citizens and Permanent Residents required to complete registration through the e-Register system at Ministry of Foreign Affairs website via:

www.mfa.gov.bn/Pages/eRegister.aspx

Travel Medical Insurance with COVID-19 coverage:

Brunei Citizens and Permanent Residents must obtain Travel
Medical Insurance with COVID-19 coverage (minimum coverage of BND\$50,000) with insurance validity for the entire duration of the travel.

Compliance with oversea's travel requirements:

5 Fulfill any other requirements as required by the destination country.
