- <u>PNR'S:</u> Cases where flight has not been yet re-protected, passengers who still want to travel on the same routing on an earlier or later date (24h before or after original departure only) are permitted to re-book within the same RBD FOC on TG 3 digit flights or TG 4 digit codeshare flights operated by THAI Smile (WE) only.

For passengers who wish to re-book, tickets must be re-issued as involuntary and endorsed with the following:

'Reissue as invol due flight delay TG917/21NOV22' (Outbound and Inbound flights must be re-issued at the same time)

3. <u>Cancellation of Booking & Refund:</u>
