Dear Partner,

Qatar Airways flight operations remain temporarily suspended due to the closure of Qatari airspace.

Qatar Airways will resume operations once the Qatar Civil Aviation Authority announces the safe reopening of Qatari airspace. A further update will be provided on March 8 by 09:00 Doha time (06:00 UTC).

Following temporary authorisation from the Qatar Civil Aviation Authority confirming a safe operating corridor, Qatar Airways intends to operate repatriation flights on 07 March, departing Hamad International Airport to the following airports: **London (LHR), Paris (CDG), Madrid (MAD), Rome (FCO), Frankfurt (FRA).**

Priority on these flights was given to stranded passengers with families, elderly passengers, and those with urgent medical and compassionate travel needs. Each flight was pre-allocated by Qatar Airways directly to such affected passengers.

These flights do not constitute a confirmation of resumption of scheduled commercial operations.

Your clients are kindly requested not to proceed to the airport unless they have received an official notification from Qatar Airways confirming their flight.

Qatar Airways has contacted affected passengers directly with their assigned flight details, travel arrangements and next steps.

We are working around the clock to organise additional relief flights where operationally possible and will share further updates as soon as they are confirmed

We are continuing to closely monitor the situation and will share further updates as soon as they become available.

The safety and wellbeing of our passengers and crew remains our highest priority. We apologise for the disruption caused by circumstances beyond our control due to the temporary airspace closure and thank you for your patience.

If your client has a confirmed booking with a travel date between 28 February and 15 March 2026, they are eligible for: Complimentary date changes of up to 14 days from the original travel date, or a refund of the unused value of their ticket.
