



Baggage Policy

Baggage Policy (General Service) for Thai Airways International Public Company Ltd.

General Information

Baggage allowance determination and checked baggage option apply through checked from the point of departure to the point of arrival without stopover at any of intermediate points. If passenger takes a stopover at an intermediate point, a new assessment of baggage allowance and baggage charge, if applicable, will be measured from the point of departure following the stopover.

Application to Thai Airways International Public Company Ltd.

When passengers travel with Thai Airways for domestic and international flights, passengers allowed carrying free of charge baggage which may include extra charge and subject to the conditions and limitations in THAI regulations.

Standard Free Baggage Allowance

The piece concept allowance is applied by THAI across its global network for a journey:

Effective **25 November 2025**, for sales, ticket issuance, and reissuance of totally unused tickets, and for travel commencing on or after **02 March 2026**, a new baggage policy based on the Piece Concept will be implemented for the following routes:

- Wholly within Thailand Domestic sector
- A journey within TC3 (Asia, Australia, New Zealand)
- A journey between TC2 (Europe, Africa, Middle East) and TC3 (Asia, Australia, New Zealand)

Effective **28 November 2025**, for sales, ticket issuance, and reissuance of totally unused tickets, and for travel commencing on or after **02 March 2026**, a new baggage policy based on the Piece Concept will be implemented for the following routes:

- A journey between TC3 (Asia, Australia, New Zealand) and TC1 (North America, South America)

Checked Baggage – Dimension Allowance



For all classes, each checked bag must not exceed a total dimension of 158 cm (62 inches) (height + width + length), including wheels and handles.

Checked Baggage – Weight Allowance



Each piece may weigh up to 32 kg (70 lbs) for Royal First Class, Royal Silk Class, and Premium Economy Plus Class.



Each piece may weigh up to 23 kg (50 lbs) for Premium Economy Class and Economy Class.

High Important

- When a passenger is involuntarily reissue to a lower class of service, the higher-class baggage allowance shall be applied even though the refund for the fare difference is made.
- In case of travel on combined services for through journeys where the passenger travels in mixed classes (e.g., partly in C-, U-, or Y-class), the free baggage allowance shall be determined based on the highest class of service for which the fare is paid.
For example, if the passenger has paid a C-class fare but travels partly in U-, or Y-class, the C-class baggage allowance shall apply.
- One (1) foldable stroller, car seat, or wheelchair may be loaded in the aircraft at no additional charge, limited to one (1) piece per passenger, provided it is required for the passenger's use (e.g., wheelchair for passengers who are elderly, ill, or have a disability). No weight or size restrictions apply to this item. If it does not meet the above conditions (e.g., more than one (1) piece or not required for the passenger's use), it will be treated as normal baggage and the applicable baggage rules will apply.
- Baggage must be properly packed to prevent damage. Thai Airways reserves the right to refuse acceptance as checked baggage if it is not properly packed.

High Important

1. When a passenger is involuntarily reissue to a lower class of service, the higher-class baggage allowance shall be applied even though the refund for the fare difference is made.
2. In case of travel on combined services for through journeys where the passenger travels in mixed classes (e.g., partly in F-, C-, U-, or Y-class), the free baggage allowance shall be determined based on the highest class of service for which the fare is paid.
For example, if the passenger has paid a F-class fare but travels partly in C-class, the F-class baggage allowance shall apply.
3. One (1) foldable stroller, car seat, or wheelchair may be loaded in the aircraft at no additional charge, limited to one (1) piece per passenger, provided it is required for the passenger's use (e.g., wheelchair for passengers who are elderly, ill, or have a disability). No weight or size restrictions apply to this item. If it does not meet the above conditions (e.g., more than one (1) piece or not required for the passenger's use), it will be treated as normal baggage and the applicable baggage rules will apply.
4. Baggage must be properly packed to prevent damage. Thai Airways reserves the right to refuse acceptance as checked baggage if it is not properly packed.
5. If your journey involves multiple airline partners, please be aware that baggage rule may vary. In case of code-share flights, the carrier performing as the Most Significant Carrier (MSC) determines the baggage rule, will be the Marketing Carrier unless that carrier publishes a rule stipulate that it will be the Operation Carrier. In some cases, the baggage rule that applied for your journey may those of our partner airlines. Excess Baggage Policy

Applicability: This policy applies to all passenger who check in baggage exceeding the standard free baggage allowance defined by number of pieces, weight, or size (dimension) based on cabin class, fare brand, and frequent flyer tier, including:

- Airport - purchased excess baggage at check in counter and TG airport ticketing office.
- Prepaid excess baggage - purchased online, via call center, TG city ticketing office, or agent at least 24 hours before the scheduled departure time before first flight segment.

Additional Piece: When purchasing an additional piece, the dimension must not exceed 158 cm (62 inch) and the following maximum weight per piece applies, based on the cabin class.

- First/ Business class: Additional Piece (Max Weight) 32 kg per piece.
- Premium Economy/ Economy class: Additional Piece (Max Weight) 23 kg per piece.

Pricing: Flat rate by Zone applies as follows:

- **Rate apply per piece by zoning basis:** Defined geographical group of destination countries.
- **Overweight & Oversized Charges:** if any checked-in baggage or an excess piece exceeds the standard weight or dimension allowance (23/32 kg or 158 cm linear) limits per piece, overweight or oversized charges will be collected at the airport based on the applicable Airport Zone Rate.
 - **Overweight**
 - For passengers with a Free Baggage Allowance of 23 kg per piece, overweight charges apply as follows:
 - 23–32 kg:
→ **Charge 1x Airport Zone Rate**
 - For passengers with a Free Baggage Allowance of 32 kg per piece, overweight baggage is not permitted, as the maximum weight per piece is restricted to 32 kg in accordance with labor regulations in certain countries.
 - **Oversized**
 - 158–200 cm (62–79 inches):
→ **Charge 1x Airport Zone Rate**
 - 200–330 cm (79–130 inches) (Bulky Baggage):
→ **Charge an additional 1x Airport Zone Rate**
- **Conditions: Non-refundable, including both partial and full refunds.**

SPORT EQUIPMENT AND SPECIAL BAGGAGE

Special unit pricing (flat rates) applies to sports equipment and special baggage, and is applicable on Thailand domestic journeys as well as international journeys within TC3, between TC2 and TC3, between TC2 and TC1, and between TC3 and TC1.

The flat rate varies by direction of journey and type of equipment. Passenger can take sport equipment or special baggage with maximum weight 32 kg per piece which may include extra charge and subject to specific handling conditions and regulatory limitations.

The following items verified as sporting equipment such as *bicycle, bowling, fishing, golfing, snow/water skiing, scuba diving and surfboard, windsurf, sporting firearms, weapons firearms ammunition* and special baggage such as *musical instrument, Oversized (Bulky Baggage)*.

- **Cabin baggage in seat or CBBG (Musical instrument, Diplomatic courier, etc.)**

- For musical instruments or valuable/fragile items such as a cello, it is recommended to place them at a window seat or the last seat row adjoining the passenger's seat.
- Special rule for cello: A cello can be accepted with total dimensions not exceeding length 150cm x height 35cm x width 50cm (59.05 x 13.78 x 19.69 inches).
- Limitations for cabin baggage (CBBG) are 50kg per item per seat / maximum dimensions shall be allowed according to aircraft type as follow;
 - A320/321: Length 17 x width 16 x height 24 inches (42.5cm x 40cm x 60cm).
 - Other than A320: CBBG will be accepted according to class of service
 - First class: Length 19in x width 19in x height 24in (48.26cm x 48.26cm x 60.96cm).
 - Business class: Length 17in x width 19in x height 24in (43.18cm x 48.26cm x 60.96cm).
 - Premium Economy Plus / Premium Economy / Economy class: Length 17in x width 16in x height 24in (43.18cm x 40.64cm x 60.96cm).
- The cabin baggage must be secured by a seatbelt at all times during the flight.
- Reservation for CBBG must be made at least 2 days prior to departure.
- The applicable charge rate may vary depending on the passenger's ticket fare.

- **Other Special Baggage:**

- Bulky Baggage must be properly packed to prevent damage. Thai Airways reserves the right to refuse acceptance as checked baggage if it is not properly packed.

Note

1. The above "Sport equipment" and "Special baggage" is effective for travel on/ after 02-March-2026 until further notice.
2. The request must be done completely at least 3 working days in advance. Passengers should present at check-in counter at least 2 hours prior to the departure time.
3. The price lists here are charged per route at direction of journey each time (from one bag drop-off to the next) and are valid exclusively for Thai Airways operated flights.
4. Some equipment may not allow for every aircraft type.
5. Total dimension in any equipment depends on type of item.

6. Other sports equipment and special baggage, whether mentioned above or not, with a weight per piece exceeding 32 kg (70 lbs) or dimensions exceeding 330 cm will not be accepted.

7. Other sporting equipment may be included within the free baggage allowance, provided that it complies with the standard baggage limits for weight, dimensions, and number of pieces.

Any item exceeding the free baggage allowance in terms of number of pieces will be charged at one (1) unit per excess piece.

If the sporting equipment exceeding the free baggage allowance in terms of number of pieces and exceeds either the standard weight allowance or the standard dimension allowance, a charge of two (2) units will apply.

If the sporting equipment exceeding the free baggage allowance in terms of number of pieces and exceeds both the standard weight and dimension allowances, a charge of three (3) units will apply.

Charges are not cumulative.

For international sectors (including journeys to/from domestic Thailand), the charge is USD 180 or THB 6,255 per unit.

For domestic sectors within Thailand only, the charge is THB 1,520 per unit.

8. Sporting equipment must be properly packed to prevent damage. Thai Airways reserves the right to refuse acceptance as checked baggage if the equipment is not properly packed.

ANIMAL IN HOLD (AVIH)

THAI accept only dogs and cats to be transported as AVIH, other kind of pets must be transported only as manifested cargo under cargo restrictions.

Conditions for Acceptance

THAI will accept dog/cat for carriage as checked baggage on the same flight as the passenger.

1. The age of dog/cat must be older than 4 months old for international flight and no restriction on domestic flight.
2. Only one dog (or cat) stays in one container except:
 - 2.1 Two puppies or small dogs or kittens are allowed in one container.
 - 2.2 Maximum total weight of small dogs or kittens is 10 kg. /container.
3. SNUB-NOSED and some other dog breeds due to their anatomical abnormalities are more vulnerable to changes in air quality and temperature. Their respiratory conditions become worse when flying at high altitudes. Therefore, they are more likely to concerned health conditions (death) on airplanes or at sorting area where temperature can be very hot or too cold. For the safety of these pets, TG will not allow the following dogs breeds to be transported,
 - Bulldog
 - English / French Bulldog
 - American Bulldog / Bully
 - Pit Bull
 - American Pitbull Terrier
 - American Staffordshire Terrier
 - Staffordshire Bull Terrier
 - Boston Terrier
 - Boxer
 - Japanese Boxer
 - Brussels Griffon
 - Pug
 - Chinese / Dutch / Japanese Pug
 - Chow Chow
 - English Toy Spaniel
 - Lhasa Apso
 - Japanese Spaniel (Chin)
 - Mastiff (All Breeds)
 - Pekinese
 - Shar Pei
 - Shih Tzu
 - Tibetan Spaniel
4. TG may not accept the total weight of animal included container exceeds 70 kg.
5. Pet must be healthy and not pregnant.
6. AVIH are not applicable for aircraft **A320 type**.
7. AVIH is not included in baggage allowance.
8. Charges are applied based on total weight per animal including its container and the direction of journey.
9. **Pets as AVIH are not allowed on the following routes due to quarantine or other conditions.**
 - **Flight to Auckland, Denpasar, Dubai, and Hong Kong.**
 - **Flight to/from Brisbane, Melbourne, Perth and Sydney.**
 - **For flight to/from London, AVIH exceeding 32 kg. per piece must be sent via cargo.**

- **Within Domestic Journey**

The charge for AVIH will be applied to all TG operating flights according to the following table. Total weight included container **up to 70 kg**.

1. The above "AVIH" is effective for travel on/after 02-March-2026 until further notice.
2. "AVIH" must be assessed and charged before the passenger board the aircraft.
3. The request must be done completely at least 3 working days in advance. Passengers should present at check-in counter at least 2 hours prior to the departure time.
4. Passenger must provide a suitable container which used for air transportation i.e., strong leakage proof, clean, disinfected and covered with a layer of moisture absorbing material as the bottom such as wood shavings or sawdust except for hay straw, and suitable for pet to stand, lie down and turnaround in natural manner.
5. Passenger must provide sufficient food and water for the journey included transit/transfer period.
6. Preparing required documentations for entry, health and /or transfer to countries enroute (No document required for travel on TG domestic flight).
7. For purely domestic and travel commencing from BKK, charge rate applies in THB currency. For International, charge rate is separated shown in USD Currency. (converted to the local currency by using the Banker's Selling Rate on the date of AVIH charged)

Annex: Conclusion of Most Significant Carrier (MSC) by IATA Baggage Resolution 302

IATA Baggage Resolution 302 related to baggage provision

RESOLVED that,

Unless otherwise agreed the following baggage provisions selection process should apply for interline journeys.

1. Baggage provisions are defined as free baggage allowance rules and baggage charges.
2. For the purposes of baggage provision selection, the following four-step process should apply for interline journeys:
 - a. If the published baggage provisions among all participating carriers are the same; these provisions will apply.
 - b. Where the one or more published baggage provisions differ between participating carriers, apply any common provisions and where provisions differ, the published baggage provisions of the Most Significant Carrier (MSC).

(In case of codeshare flights this will be the Marketing Carrier, unless that carrier publishes a rule stipulating that it will be the Operating Carrier).

- c. If the MSC does not publish baggage provisions for the journey concerned, apply the published baggage provisions of the carrier accepting the baggage at check-in.
 - d. If the carrier accepting the baggage at check-in does not publish baggage provisions for the interline journey concerned, apply the published baggage provisions of each operating airline sector-by-sector.
3. MOST SIGNIFICANT CARRIER (MSC)
 - a. For travel between two or more IATA areas, the carrier performing carriage on the first sector that crosses from one area to another.
Exception: For travel across all 3 IATA areas, the carrier performing carriage on the first sector that crosses between IATA areas 1 and 2.
 - b. For travel between IATA Tariff sub-areas, the carrier performing carriage on the first sector that crosses from one sub-area to another.
 - c. For travel within an IATA Tariff sub-area, the carrier performing carriage on the first international sector.

IATA defines the world into 3 areas, and defines the IATA area into small areas (IATA Tariff sub-area).

IATA Area 1: North America / South America / Hawaii etc.

IATA Area sub-areas: North America (USA, Canada and Mexico) / Caribbean Islands / Central America / South America (Brazil, Chile, Peru etc.)

IATA Area 2: Europe / Middle East etc.

IATA Area sub-areas: Europe / Russia (West of the Urals) / Africa / Middle East

IATA Area 3: Japan / South Korea / Thailand / Singapore / Philippines / India / Guam etc.

IATA Area sub-areas: Russia (East of the Urals) / Japan and South Korea / South East Asia (China, Singapore, Thai, Vietnam, Guam etc.) / South Asia (India etc.) / South East Pacific (Australia, New Zealand etc.)
